Marcus Borg, internationally known biblical and Jesus scholar, professor and author, joins **Huston Smith**, one of the world's leading scholars of comparative religions, professor and author, for a special Friday evening lecture and Saturday morning workshop.

Friday Evening Lecture “The Heart and Soul of Christianity” at 7:30 pm in the FCCB Sanctuary, \$10/\$5 students suggested donation.

Saturday Workshop “The Heart and Soul of Christianity: The Conversation Continues” from 9:30 am to noon in the FCCB Large Assembly, \$30.

Borg's newest book, *Jesus: The Life, Teachings and Relevance of a Religious Revolutionary*, will be released in late October, 2006. He is the author of fourteen books, including the best sellers *Meeting Jesus Again for the First Time* (1994), and *The Heart of Christianity* (2003). Walter Brueggemann of Columbia Theological Seminary describes Marcus Borg as “a key force in the emerging ‘new paradigm’ of Christian faith.” Smith's most recent work is *The Soul of Christianity: Restoring the Great Tradition* (2005), which follows thirteen other books, including *The World's Religions: A Guide to our Wisdom Traditions* (which sold over 2 million copies). Smith was featured in a 5-part PBS Special by Bill Moyers in 1997 on “The Wisdom of Faith with Huston Smith.”
